WELCOME!

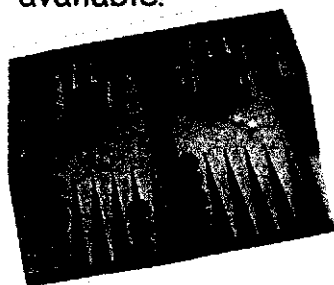
